

Installation instructions

Please read these instructions carefully. DC SHORT LTD cannot be held responsible if the installation and use of the towel rail is not carried out in accordance with the instructions given below or for materials not supplied by DC SHORT LTD.

SAFETY

The towel rail is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervision. Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance. The towel rail has been designed to withstand the loads expected during normal operation as a towel rail. The towel rail is not a ladder and should not be used as such.

ELECTRICAL

The towel rail must be wired by a registered electrician and must be earthed. An isolating switch must be positioned near the towel rail. If the supply cord is damaged the entire towel rail must be returned to DC SHORT LTD for repair.

WALL MOUNTING

The towel rail is designed to be fixed through wall cladding into solid wall framing, solid cementitious, or masonry walls. Plasterboard toggles, of at least 3mm diameter, may be used for 2 of the towel rail fixings. The recommended installation height is 1600mm from the floor to the top of the rail.

CARE & CLEANING

Do not use cream cleansers. Do not use spray on detergents. Use a soft cloth and warm soapy water or a silicone based household wax/polish such as SC Johnson 'Pledge' for general polishing and cleaning of the appliance. Fine scratching can be removed using the correct metal polish. Recommended brands are 'Autosol' and 'Brasso Paste', both available in tubes from supermarkets and car care outlets.

INSTALLATION

- Place the towel rail against the wall in the desired position, to line up with wall framing where applicable.
- Using a fine pencil, or by gently pressing the rail against the wall, mark the position of all four rail legs.. See fig 1.0

IMPORTANT

- Ensure that all four legs touch the wall when the towel rail is in the correct position against the wall.
- A gap of no more than 2mm is ideal. see Fig 2.0
- If there is an excessive gap, one of the legs could be recessed to correct the wall alignment. see Fig 3.0
- Do not be tempted to flex the towel rail to close a large gap during final assembly as this will damage the towel rail and/or the mounting inserts.

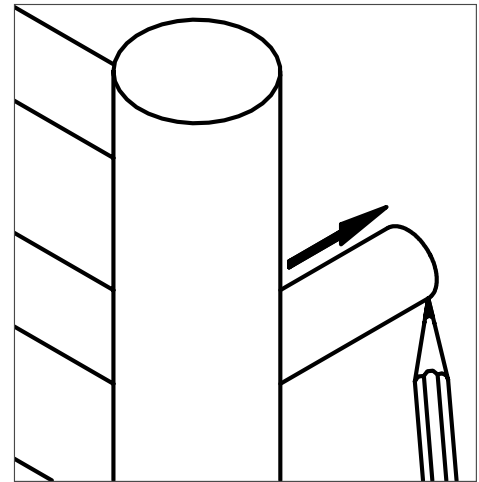

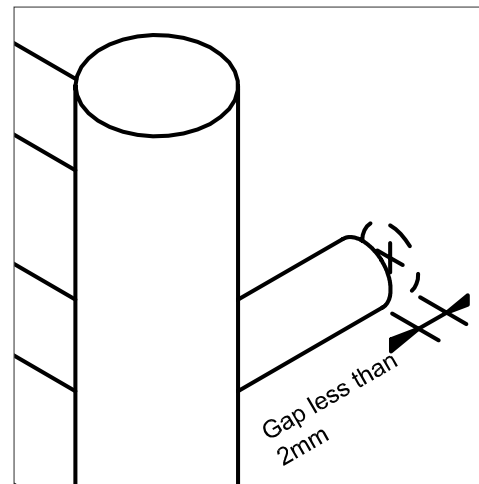

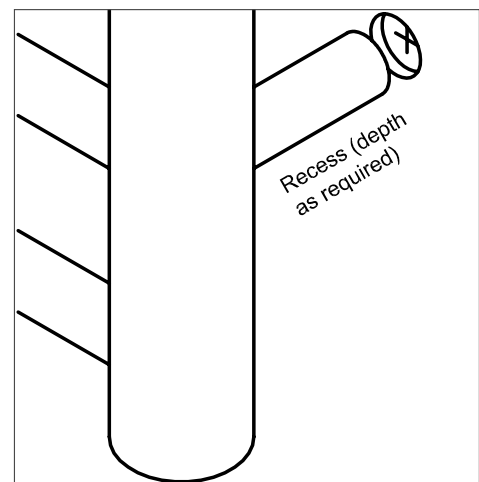

INSTALLATION CONTINUED...

- Screw the mounting inserts securely to the wall at the locations marked. see Fig 4.0
- A small amount of vaseline applied to each mounting insert at this time will make assembly easier.
- Press the towel rail onto the mounting inserts gradually, checking that each leg is lined up with the mounting inserts before applying force. see Fig 5.0
- Screw self tapping screws into each of the four legs so that the rail is securely fixed. see Fig 6.0

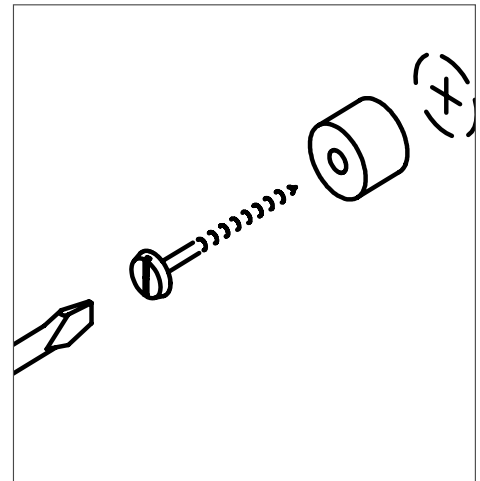

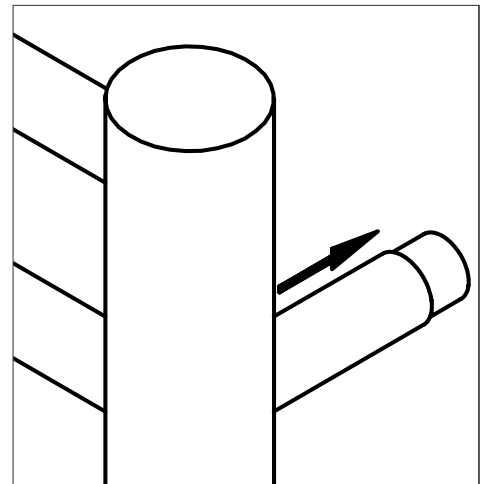

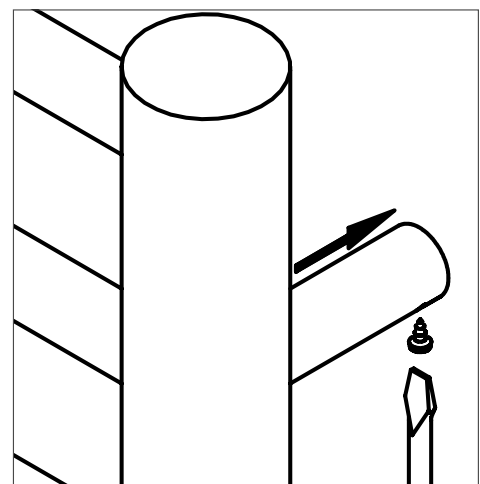
